

## Directions to Pickering Church

**From York:** from the A64 York- Scarborough Bypass, turn off where signed for Pickering on the A169 (to Whitby). As you enter the market town of Pickering you will see the parish church at the left of you, clearly visible by its spire.

To park, at the roundabout in Pickering turn right (towards Scarborough) and then immediately left, just beyond the public lavatories, into the Pay and Display Car Park.

From the car park, walk to the car park exit, cross Whitby Road (there is a pelican crossing towards your right) and walk up, just beyond the pelican crossing. Turn left which brings you into Hallgarth (and in front of the Old Rectory). Walk down by the Parish Hall and turn left. A passageway there leads into the churchyard. It is the only access suitable for wheelchairs, and you will find at the church assigned route for wheelchair access into the church.

**From Helmsley:** Enter the market town of Pickering on the A170 from Helmsley. You will see the parish church towards the left of you, clearly visible by its spire.

To park, go across the roundabout and turn immediately left, just beyond the public lavatories, into the Pay and Display Car Park. Then follow directions to the church as given above.

**From Scarborough:** Enter the market town of Pickering on the A170 from Scarborough. You will see the parish church ahead of you, clearly visible by its spire.

To park, before you enter the roundabout turn right, just before the public lavatories, into the Pay and Display Car Park. Then follow directions to the church as given above.

**From Whitby:** Enter the market town of Pickering on the A169 from Whitby. You will see the parish church to the right of you, clearly visible by its spire.

To park, enter the roundabout and turn left. Then turn immediately left, just beyond the public lavatories, into the Pay and Display Car Park. Then follow directions to the church as given above.
